SCHOOL PROPERTIES DISPOSITION

The Colorado Springs School District 11 Board of Education (the Board) has the authority to sell, allow use for cost of operations or lease any Colorado Springs School District 11 (the District) property which may not be needed in the foreseeable future upon such terms and conditions as it may approve.

If the property is sold to a state agency or any political subdivision of the state, it shall not be necessary to determine District "need".

The Superintendent or designee shall issue instructions as to the proper disposal of obsolete equipment and/or materials including books.

After the Board has determined that certain buildings and/or land may no longer be needed, the administration shall recommend a plan for disposition.
