RELATIONS WITH LAW ENFORCEMENT AUTHORITIES

A cooperative effort will be maintained between the officials of Colorado Springs School District 11 (the District) and law enforcement agencies. In this effort, it is paramount that the rights of the school, the home, the civil authorities and of the individual be clearly understood and protected.

This cooperative effort will pursue the following primary objectives:

- 1. Protection of the safety and welfare of students
- 2. Protection of the civil and human rights of the individual
- 3. Education in constructive law-abiding citizenship.
- 4. Instruction in the police function in a democratic society
- 5. Protection of the property of the schools and the orderliness of their function

The District may enter into written agreements with local law enforcement and the juvenile justice system to promote and maintain a safe school environment. The Security Department will be the primary liaison between the District and law enforcement authorities.
