## **RELATIONS WITH COMMUNITY FUND-RAISING GROUPS**

All nonschool-related businesses/organizations offering to raise funds for the benefit of Colorado Springs School District 11 (District) students or staff shall be required to coordinate their activities through the office of Volunteer Services and Community Partnerships.

Nonschool-related businesses/organizations include, but are not limited to, private businesses, service clubs, civic groups, or online fundraising opportunities.

The funds, directly or indirectly, shall be of educational benefit. When a student or students will be the beneficiaries of fund-raising activities, the funds collected shall be turned over to the school and re-distributed to the students at the directions of the building principal in collaboration with the Superintendent or designee.

All activities must conform to existing local, state or federal laws.
