## ADMISSION OF NONRESIDENT STUDENTS/TUITION CHARGES

The parents or guardians of Colorado students who are not residents of this school district and who are admitted shall not be charged tuition. All applications shall be considered in accordance with the policy on inter-district choice/open enrollment.

The district may enter into a written agreement with any student's district of residence under which the district of residence agrees to pay tuition to allow the student to attend school within the district. Neither district shall be required to provide transportation at public expense.

When a nonresident student with a disability enrolls and attends school in this district, the student's district of residence shall be responsible for paying the tuition charge for educating the student in accordance with state laws and regulations. The amount of the tuition shall be determined pursuant to a contract entered into between the two districts.

Out-of-state students who wish to attend school in this district may be charged tuition in accordance with the rates adopted by the board on an annual basis.

The superintendent shall present to the board for its consideration any request from parents or legal guardians for exceptions to this policy.
