

ADULT AND FAMILY EDUCATION

Adult and Family Education in Colorado Springs School District 11 (the District) shall serve all residents of El Paso County, Colorado, 17 years of age and older, and shall receive financial support through federal and state grants, private funding and District matching funds.

Adult education shall comply with all federal and state guidelines and shall exist under the auspices of the District. The Director of Adult and Family Education shall be responsible for the ongoing operation of the program and falls under the direction of the Executive Director of Alternative and Nontraditional Education.

The program will charge tuition and book fees as allowed per grant guidelines and the District will make an operating transfer sufficient enough to place the District in compliance with the financial matching requirements of the Adult Education and Family Literacy Act (AEFLA) and EL/Civics grant during the beginning of each fiscal year.

Certificates of achievement will be awarded at the end of the program year to students who have had an attendance record of at least 75% and have completed at least one instructional performance level as defined by the National Reporting System.
