

AFTER SCHOOL DETENTION OF STUDENTS

Detention of a student after completion of the school day may be used as a disciplinary measure. Time in detention shall be spent in a manner that will assist the student in the development of responsible behavior. When repeated detention fails to develop responsible student behavior, the student shall be referred to the Principal or designee to pursue other means of discipline.

Students shall not be kept in school after the usual dismissal time for detention without prior arrangement with and consent of a parent/guardian.
